The exhibition and congress operator will make its spaces available for the major sporting event.

Speed Skating competitions, all matches of the women's Ice Hockey tournament, and select matches of the men's tournament will be held at Fiera Milano.

Milan, January 21, 2025 – Fiera Milano and Fondazione Milano Cortina 2026 have signed a partnership agreement to establish a strategic collaboration that brings Italy's leading exhibition and congress operator into the team of partners for Milano Cortina 2026.
